How Do I Get My Securities Industry Essential (SIE)

Overview

The Securities Industry Essentials (SIE) certification is a pre-requisite for the New Advisor Development Program (NADP) and must be obtained prior to joining the program.

This introductory-level FINRA exam assesses a candidate's knowledge of basic securities industry information including concepts fundamental to working in the industry, such as types of products and their risks; the structure of the securities industry markets, regulatory agencies, and their functions; and prohibited practices.

Getting Started

To get started, please visit <u>Securities Industry Essentials</u>® (SIE®) <u>Exam | FINRA.org</u>
Your candidate will need to create an account and enroll to take the SIE. The enrollment process includes paying for the exam. Once the enrollment is approved, your candidate has a 120-day window in which the exam must be taken.

- 1. Create an account.
- 2. Enroll for the SIE, paying with credit card or ACH, or by redeeming a voucher.
- 3. <u>Schedule your exam</u>. You have the option to test either at a Prometric test center or online.
